Epic Scouting Program 2011 – FAQ Sheet

Epic is a program of Life Adventure Center, a non-profit experiential education facility in Woodford County

Epic Scouting is a 5 weekend wilderness living program designed exclusively for Boy Scouts

In addition to having extensive backcountry experience, your Epic Instructor is certified as a BSA Merit Badge Counselor.

Investment: \$50 per person per weekend

Limit 15 participants per weekend

Each camping excursion option will be offered at least 3 times to best fit everybody's busy schedule.

No experience or gear necessary. Group gear is provided as part of tuition (tent, stove, fuel, food, bear precautions, etc).

Individual gear (such as backpack, sleeping bag, sleeping pad) is available for rent

A participant has the potential to earn up to 5 merit badges by going on all 5 camping excursion options and completing some necessary homework.

Minimum age is 13.

An instructor will come to one of your scout meetings before any of the campouts for a

FREE gear class to prepare for this program.
